Dear Fulton Parents,

Please ensure that your children are reading, writing, and doing arithmetic to improve upon their academic skills. #### **Testing**

Students in grades 2-8 completed their 1<sup>st</sup> Acuity Benchmark tests. The test monitors student's progress in math and English Language Arts. Please follow-up with your child and their teacher to monitor their progress. Teachers are available via phone, email, and by scheduling a time that is convenient for both you and the teacher to meet in person.

## **Report Cards**

Report cards for elementary school students will be mailed out the week of November 12, 2012. Progress report cards for middle school students will be distributed to students on Friday, December 7, 2012. Please **DO NOT** wait for progress reports and report cards to enquire about your child's academic performance. You can always phone, email, and/or schedule a meeting with your child's teacher.

#### **Daily Attendance**

It is imperative that our students attend school <u>EVERYDAY</u>. Fulton can only be successful if all members of the team are present.
